BURNIE ATHLETIC CLUB INC NEW YEAR'S EVE CARNIVAL TICKETING POLICY AND PROCEDURES **For Burnie New Year Sports on Friday 31/12/2021**

- BAC's Covid-19 policy stipulates the mandatory traceability of all persons who enter the venue
- Venue entry by e' ticket for patrons or purchase on the day. Competitors, officials, service providers and BAC members to sign in.
- All people to use Check in App on the day.
- The BAC Covid-19 event management plan has been approved by the Tasmanian State Government Dept of Health and is designed to protect your safety as far as possible
- E' tickets can be purchased at <https://burnietickets.com.au/>
- Fast gate lane entry for those who hold pre-purchased e' tickets
- Tickets can be purchased at the gate, but you may experience queuing and delays, so it makes sense to get in early and pre-purchase
- Attendee numbers are limited to 5,000 and subject to the permit conditions of the Tasmanian State Government Dept of Health.
- The full value of your e' ticket may be refunded within 7 days if the carnival is cancelled due to inclement weather, an Act of God or if the event was cancelled due to a Dept of Health directive. A reduced carnival program does not constitute a cancellation. In such circumstances you must apply for a refund no later than 7th January 2022 via the burnie tickets web site
- On no account can you resell or give your e' ticket to another person as this would void BAC's Covid-19 management plan and Tasmanian State Government legislated Covid-19 traceability
- Pass outs will be available.
- Privacy policy. In accordance with BAC's privacy policy all names, address and contact details will be erased by 31st January 2022 unless otherwise directed by the Tasmanian State Government which can only occur in the event of a patron testing positive to Covid by 15th January 2022.
